#### **7 Red Flags for Funders** in Your Grant Proposal

To be successful, a grant proposal must convince the funder that your activity will have value and impact in the community.



Writing an effective proposal requires a tactical approach that combines inspiring creativity and compelling supporting data, while carefully reading and following the guidelines ("rules") established by the funder.

Grant proposals take a lot of work. Nobody wants to see their proposal get discarded by a funder for something that could have been easily fixed. This article provides seven (7) specific tips that will make it more likely for proposal to be funded.

also look at key elements regarding compliance with various IRS rules for charities.

Although the IRS uses the form filing for compliance and monitoring purposes, it also serves to tell the organiza-tion's story through the narrative sections. Anyone can request a copy of your 990 from the IRS, and it is required that your 990 be available at your office (local and regional offices) for anyone to review.

**READ MORE** to learn the key elements of each of the IRS Forms (990-N, 990-EZ, 990), when to file, how to get an extension for filing and where to file. It's important to file annual returns on a timely basis and not assume that your nonprofit is exempt from filing a return just because it is exempt from paying federal taxes.

#### Central Florida Community Arts retrenches, refocuses as it makes financial progress

Two months after revealing a financial crisis, CFCArts officials say they have made up \$500,000 of an estimated \$600,000 budget gap for the year. The Dr Phillips Center for the Performing Arts has filed suit to collect more than \$3 million in unpaid pledges from one of its earliest and largest donors, the Orlando-based CNL Charitable Foundation. Interim Executive Director Justin Muchoney said "..the progress is pretty remarkable", and attributed the turnaround to community support, in particular from the organization's hundreds of members.

#### Charitable Sector Urges President Biden to Provide Critical Workforce Data Through the Bureau of Labor Statistics Read the Letter

Nonprofits currently receive workforce data every five years, which represents a disservice to our sector compared to the quarterly data most sectors of the economy receive. Florida Association of Nonprofits joined with hundreds of other national and statewide organizations and individual researchers requesting the President take executive action to support the deeply dedicated nonprofit workforce by directing the BLS to provide quarterly wage and jobs data on nonprofit organizations.
